Life in EYFS

As always, we have busy bees in Reception this week. We have been exploring outside for all sorts of mini beasts on leaves, under logs and rocks. We've got lots of budding entomologists over here! We are now starting to critique the different features of these mini beasts and their purpose. How many legs do they have? Do they have wings? What do they eat? Do they have special powers?

In literacy we have been reading 'Norman, the Slug with the Silly Shell.' Norman didn't make the best choice when he chose a doughnut for his shell because it was too delicious for a bird to resist! It also isn't very weather resistant or strong. We have thought about what would have made a better shell for him. What properties does a shell need? We have thought about which items are made of materials that might protect Norman and have written all about it! The children came up with some great ideas. We had metal shells that couldn't be penetrated by birds, glass shells that let Norman see where he was going and even plastic shells that were waterproof to protect him from the rain!



Next week we will be exploring the text 'The Bad Tempered Ladybird'. We are going to retell the story as a storyboard (with pictures and some words). Perhaps when you next read a story, you could pick out the important bits that you would put into pictures. There are lots of different ways to record stories. You can draw pictures, act them out, record them as a video or you can even sing a story! Can you try and create your own mini beast story at home? Which mini beasts will be your main characters? What adventures will they go on? What problem will occur? How will it be solved?

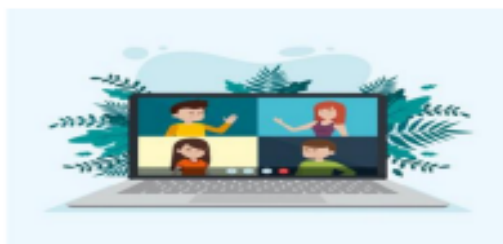
Date: Wednesday 14th May 2025
